Guideline for Details of Land History

This should be used as a guide when preparing information of detailed land history letter requested by Food For The Poor (FFP). The questions below are arranged to gather maximum information from the declarant about the land tenure.

This should must be signed by current owner/s of the land and stamped, signed and sealed by a J.P.

This letter must be accompanied by contact information and identification (government ID, Drivers License, Passport) for current land owner/s.

- 1. Name/s of previous land owner/s.
- 2. Name/s current land owner/s.
- 3. State how many children the previous land owner had, alive, deceased and have ties to the land that applicant needs assistance to build on.
- 4. State how land was passed down from previous land owner/s to current land owner/s.
- 5. If land was passed down as a gift or through a will clearly state, if it is a will a copy of such should be submitted to food for the poor.
- 6. State if land was purchased, if yes proof of purchased should be submitted to food for the poor.
- 7. If there is no proof of purchased, clearly state how many acres was purchased, the sum of money that was paid for the land, if the land is finished paid for and if it was surveyed. If yes, copy of surveyors report should be submitted to food for the poor.
- 8. State the relationship between previous lands owner/s, current land owner/s and applicant e.g. mother, father, sister, brother, cousins, aunts, grandparents.
- 9. Contact information and identification (government ID) for current land owner/s.
